GUIDELINES FOR CAPTURING AND RETRIEVING A MASCOT

1. Three Members or Associates may capture a Mascot when visiting another chapter provided the visitors have signed-in properly.
2. Four Members or Associates are required to retrieve their captured Mascot from another Chapter provided they sign-in properly.
3. You CAN NOT capture a Mascot from a Chapter that has your Mascot while picking up your Mascot. You must retrieve your Mascot from a Chapter before you can capture theirs at a subsequent meeting.
4. When more than one Chapter is trying to capture a single Mascot, the Chapter with the most points, according to the following calculation method, gets the Mascot:

$$(\text{Number of Members Present}) \times (\text{Miles from Chart Below}) = \text{Points}^*$$

5. Please treat a captured mascot with “tender loving care” to avoid damaging it in any way.
 6. A Chapter can only keep a captured mascot for two meetings or other special get-togethers. If a Chapter has been unable to retrieve their Mascot, you should return it with a bill for shipping or delivering, plus \$2.50 for a Chapter bar you have attached.
- * A Chapter Director giving up their Mascot can award up to 5,000 Points to any Chapter that has the next fundraiser scheduled within 60 days of the current visit.
